

In the name of God. Amen, I, Elizabeth Stager, of Lebanon town-
 ship, in the County of Lebanon, and State of Pennsylvania, being in good
 health of body and of sound mind memory (I raised be God for the
 same) and being desirous to settle my worldly affairs whilst I have
 strength and capacity so to do, Do, make and Publish this my last
 Will and Testament hereby revoking and making void all former Wills
 by me heretofore made, And first and principally I commit my soul
 into the hands of my creator who gave it and as my body to the care at
 the discretion of my exors. Hereinafter named. And as to such
 worldly estate wherewith it hath pleased God to entrust me I dispose
 of them as follow: It is my will that all my just debts which shall
 be by me owing at my death together with my funeral expences &
 all charges touching the proving of or otherwise concerning this my
 will shall in the first place be fully paid and satisfied and
 after payment thereof then it is my will that my house and
 price of parcel of lands wheron I now live and all my personal
 properties shall be sold by public vendue or outcry for the highest
 and best price that can be gotten for the same, And I do
 hereby Order and direct that the proceeds arising out of the sale

of my House and Lands aforesaid as also all the money due owing
and payable unto me, also the money or ready cash & the money
arising out of the sale of my personal property & the costs & charges
aforesaid, being first paid and satisfied, I shall be divided
into twelve equal shares, share and share alike, to wit,
the one twelfth part thereof unto my son Adam Stager,
one other equal twelfth part unto the children of my
deceased son Henry Stager, one other twelfth part unto my
son John Stager one other twelfth part unto my son Frederick
Stager one other twelfth part unto my son William
Stager, one other twelfth part unto my son Samuel Stager,
one other twelfth part unto my Daughter Elizabeth one
other twelfth part unto my Daughter Christina, one other
twelfth part unto my Daughter Anna Maria one other
twelfth part unto my Daughter Catharine, and one other
equal twelfth part shall be put out to interest by my here-
inafter named executors and the interest arising and accru-
ing on the same to be paid unto my Daughter Hannah,
for her own separate use, and do. I also order & direct that
if my Daughter Hannah should come to want and for her
comfort and maintenance should require more than

the interest, them and in that case it is my will I do order
and direct my executors hereinafter named to pay over to her
as much as they in their discretion may think necessary,
and in case the said Hannah should survive her husband
then the principal sum shall be paid to her, and one other
equal twelfth part, I do order and direct that it shall be put
out to interest by my hereinafter named executors and the
interest arising and accruing on the same, to be paid unto
my daughter Margaret, for her own separate use, and do
also order and direct that if my daughter Margaret should
come to want for her comfort and maintenance should re-
quire more than the interest then and in that case I order
and direct my executors hereinafter named to pay over to her
as much of the principal as they in their discretion may think
necessary and in case the said Margaret should survive her
husband then the principal sum shall be paid to her; It is
further my will that my son William shall have the choice of
my Bible, and the other of them my daughter Christina
should have, and further I do order and direct, that
my hereinafter named executors or the survivors of them
to execute a sufficient will in fee simple to the
said Margaret

purchaser or purchasers thereof or to say of my house & piece of
 land) And I do hereby nominate and appoint my son William
 Hager and my beloved son-in-law John Dork my Executors
 of this my last Will & Testament. In Witness whereof I have
