and mind do make and publish this my last will
and testament in manner and form following
that is to say In the first place I will that all
my lawful debts be fully paid as soon as
possible after my Death I give devise and
bequeath unto my beloved Wife Hannah L.
Clements of my Real and Personal Property
the House in which we now reside and out Houses
including the well and all the Land as far
as the old well One cooking stove and a perat
er belonging thereto One parlor stove One Bed
and Bedding All the carpets All the wood
and five cords of it per year chopped and
Kilned fit for burning four Fleeces of Wool
per year Twelve Pounds in money per year
paid quarterly by my other Heirs and I do
also will my said Wife may have or dispose
of all the Property that she has of her own or
or from her Father's property or any other way
whatever both Real and personal and my other
Heirs are not to interfere with any thing belong
ing to her to have and to hold the same unto
her during her natural life and at her
Death the above mentioned House and Land be
sold or equally divided between all my other
Heirs and it is further my will that all the
Real and personal Property which may remain
at the time of my Death that is not mentioned
above shall be disposed of as follows that is

To say I give devise and bequeath unto my Daugh-
 ter Mary Hannah Weston one acre of Land on the
 East side of Clements Island joining John Finken-
 op on the South twenty Rods then North by Eight
 Rods then Easterly twenty Rods to the salt
 Marsh and all the sheep she giving the four
 Fleeces above mentioned: — I also will that my
 Grand children Children of my deceased Daugh-
 ter Sarah Eldridge each to be paid six Pounds
 in money by my other heirs the same to be
 left in the hands of Edward Penel, untill they
 become of age I do further will and direct that
 all of my Real and Personal property that
 doth remain there shall be an equal partition
 and division made share and share alike
 between my son James Clements and my
 Daughter Margret Penel my Daughter
 Jane Crosby and my son Silas Clements
 and my Daughter Mary Hannah Weston
 except my wearing apparel that to be equ-
 ally divided between my two Sons. —
 I do further will that my Sons and Daugh-
 ters procure decent tomb Stones at my Death
 each paying their part for the same.
 Lastly I make and appoint my Wife Hannah
 L. Clements my sole Exetise and Fredrick
 H. Hilton my sole executor of this my last
 will and Testament.
